

Membership Fees 2017

If your child is Grade 3 (old Skill 3), please renew them as Category 2.

Those swimmers below Grade 3 need to be renewed as Category 1. **It may well be necessary to pay an additional fee to take them to Category 2, once updated competition guidelines are finalised.**

If your child is 'dual-clubbed', you need to check with the other club as to the required category, as their criteria may be different to BOK. If your daughter's other club is their 'first' club, then the ASA renewal fees must be paid to that club, not BOK. However, the BOK part of the fees (£15) must still be paid directly to BOK.

Kirklees Priority Passport holders are entitled to 25% reduction in the BOK part of the fees, upon production of a copy of the passport. This is not applicable for non-swimming members. Please see www.bokswimmingclub.co.uk (downloads/membership) to discover benefits of ASA membership.

All coaches and parent volunteers must be a member of ASA and BOK. There is a £10 annual cost for this membership. As part of your daughter's BOK membership, we require at least one parent to become a non-swimming member and to volunteer for at least two roles within the Club.

Please return your Volunteer Commitment Form as soon as possible if you haven't already done so. Please speak to a member of the committee if you are unsure about what roles are available.

It has again been agreed by the committee that the Club will pay the £10 membership fee for all non-swimming members for this year, on the understanding that our BOK Volunteer Commitment form is completed and returned.
